

Setting up OVERDRIVE to read, listen to, and watch online books, audiobooks, magazines, and video

OVERDRIVE is a platform which manages a collection of books, magazines, audiobooks, and videos. You may “borrow” material through their website or use an APP called Libby on devices such as phones and Kindles, etc.

You “borrow” items by checking them out through your library card and PIN. Checkout periods are 14 days. You can read items directly from the Overdrive website or you will install a free app on your phone or reader, such as Kindle, called Libby.
