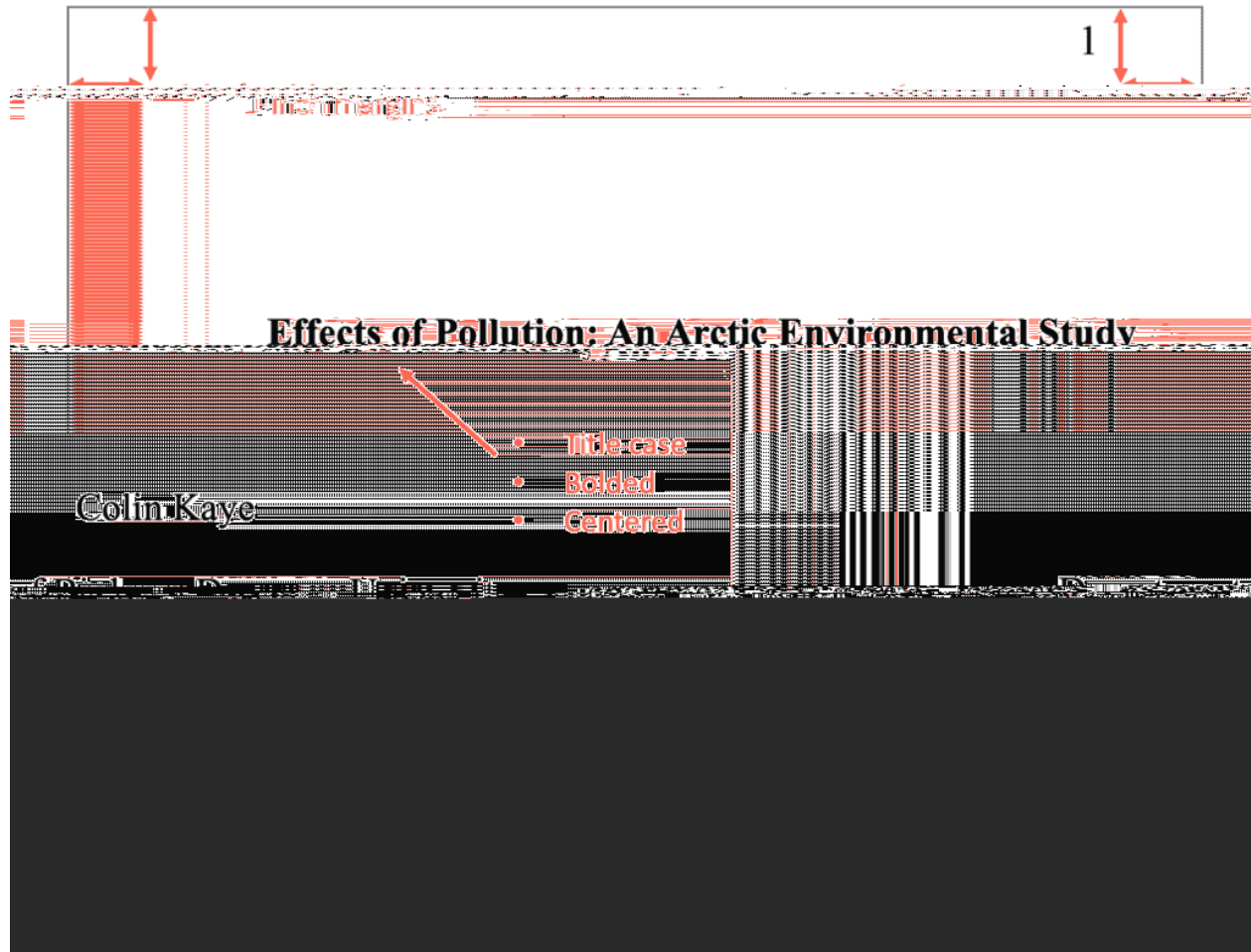

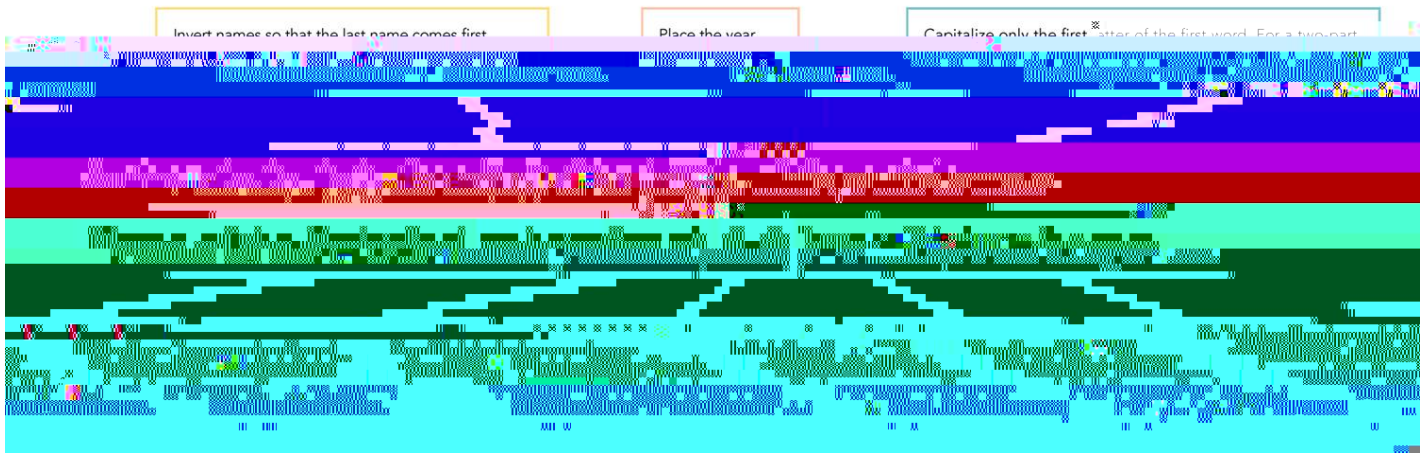


# APA Formatting Example: In Text Citation
