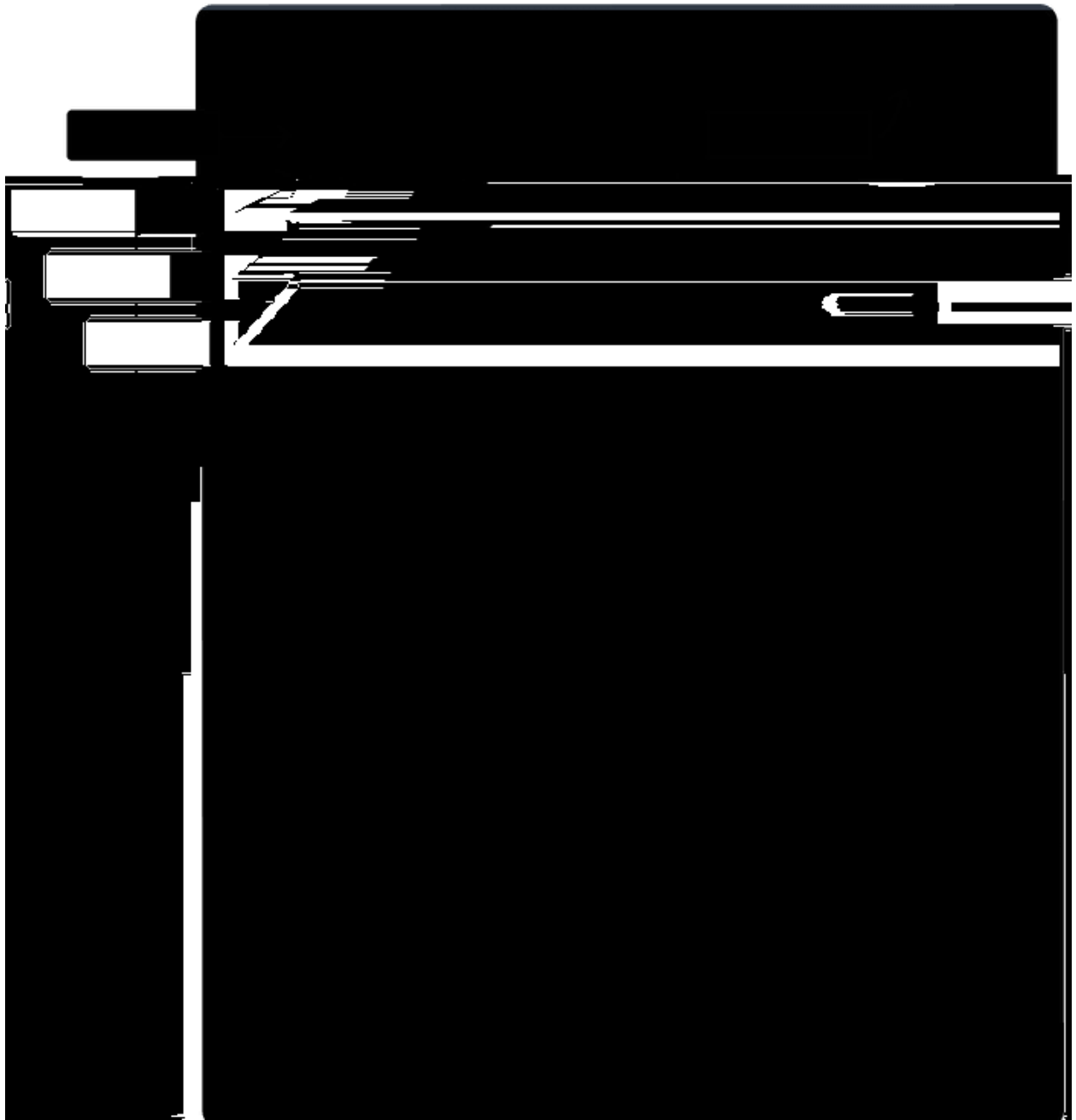

MLA Formatting Example: Cover Page



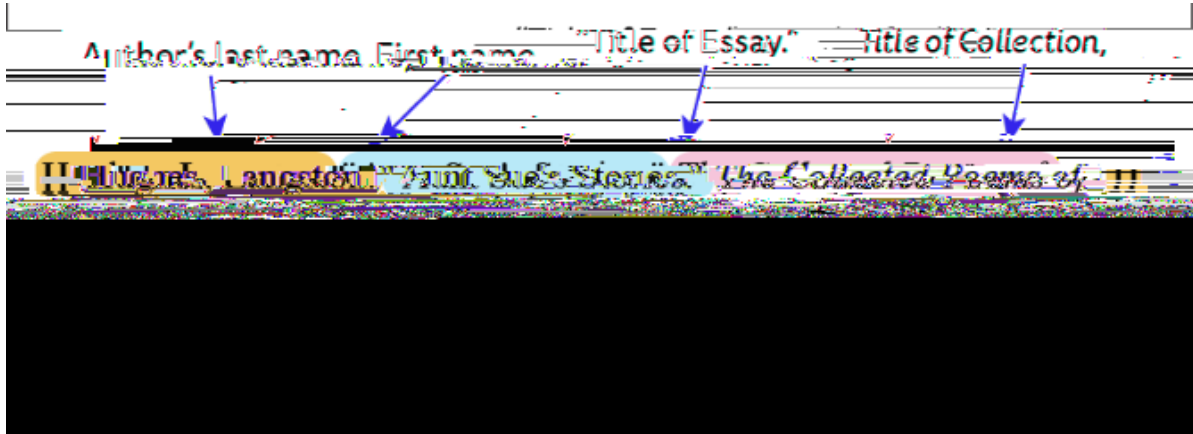
Unless specifically asked for, MLA does not usually require a cover page
